These guidelines will help you comply with the law and preserve the good reputation of Conxxion.

- Do familiarise yourself with the Policies & Procedures. When presenting the Conxxion Opportunity to others; stay truthful and follow the information provided in the Policies & Procedures document.
- Do not give a potential IBO the wrong impression by misrepresenting any of the information presented in the Policies & Procedures.
- Do not make predictions about the profitability of the Conxxion Business Opportunity. All IBO earnings are based on commissions and depend on the hard work and effort an individual IBO puts into developing their business.
- Do not present the Conxxion Business Opportunity as potential employment. All earnings are based on commissions and there is no employment relationship between you and Conxxion, you and another IBO, or another IBO and Conxxion.
- Do not advertise the Conxxion Business Opportunity in public media, such as Newspapers without prior written approval.
- Do not link to the Conxxion website without written consent from Conxxion Head Office, and do not reproduce or copy the logos, trademarks, layout or the contents of the Conxxion website.
- Do not send unsolicited messages about the Conxxion Business Opportunity to people you do not know or who have not consented to receiving this type of message - Conxxion strictly prohibits spamming!
- Be careful when presenting Conxxion's products - use the information provided on the Conxxion website and your Direct Storefront.
